Parish Education Committee Elections

PEC members are elected or appointed for a two-year term and may serve on the Committee for a maximum of 8 years (not necessarily consecutive). This year there are **three positions open for election** and one for appointment. Current members whose 8 years are not up may choose to stand for re-election, but the nominating process is now open for new members.

To serve on the PEC one must be:

- a practising Catholic, eligible to vote in this parish
- over the age of 21
- nominated by 2 people who also fit the above criteria
- approved by the pastor

There are some exceptions, and a notice with further detail is attached to this newsletter.

If more than three nominations are received, PEC elections will be held on the weekend of May 25/26, with voting taking place after each Mass. We hope that all eligible members of the parish/school community will prayerfully consider if this might be an opportunity for them to serve the parish and school for the next two years. We welcome members who bring experience in all kinds of areas, including experience at other schools.

Student Led Conferences

Each year our school is mandated to have five formal opportunities to communicate student learning to parents and guardians, in addition to any informal communication between teachers and families. This year we have issued two formal written reports (December and March) and held Parent-Teacher Interviews in October. A final written report will be issued on the last day of school in June.

The Student-Led Conference is an opportunity for students to showcase their own learning. Many families find this to be the most enjoyable reporting opportunity as the students can really demonstrate what they have been doing at school.

In the past, we have scheduled families into specific timeslots; however, this year it will be a drop-in event. Conferences will take place on Thursday, April 25th from 5:00 – 8:00 p.m., and on Friday, April 26th, from 9:00 a.m. to noon (regular classes will not be held that day). You are welcome to come at any time on that evening or morning.

Please be aware that other families will be in the room with you, and this is not the time for a 1:1 interview with the teacher. If there are concerns, a separate appointment should be made.

Are You Interested in Joining the Parish Education Committee?

Nomination forms are now being accepted. Forms are available from the school or parish office. Dave Homme is the PEC contact person for the election and is available to answer questions at maintenance@saintmarysschool.ca. Completed forms can be dropped off at the school or parish office. Please note that each nomination must be approved by the pastor.

PEC Elections will be held after Masses on Saturday, May 25th/Sunday, May 26th if there are more than three candidates nominated.

ELIGIBLE FOR NOMINATION (HOLD OFFICE):

Those eligible to hold office as a member of a Parish Education Committee or to represent the parish on a Regional Education Committee or are Regional Representatives (elected) are practicing Catholics, approved by the Pastor, who are eligible to vote in that parish and have reached the age of twenty-one (21), with the following exceptions:

- all employees of the CISVA or any CISVA Affiliate School;
- anyone who is part of the governance structure of any other CISVA School or CISVA Affiliate School;
- past employees of the CISVA or any CISVA affiliated school until three full calendar years have passed since the termination of employment;
- employees of the parish; and
- spouses, children, parents, brothers and sisters of persons covered as above.

PARISH EDUCATION COMMITTEE (PEC) 2023/24

The Parish Education Committee (PEC) is a group of elected and appointed St. Mary's Parishioners who work with the Principal and Pastor in the running of the school. The PEC represents the Board of Directors of the CISVA at the local level, implements the Archdiocesan policies and sets local policies for St. Mary's School.

PEC positions and meeting dates for the year will be decided once the new committee has been formed (this year, meetings were generally on the 3rd or 4th Wednesday of the month). Meetings begin at 6:30 p.m. and are open to the public. In camera sessions are for PEC members only.

If you wish to bring an item to the PEC, it must be presented to the Chairperson, in writing, 10 days in advance of the meeting.
